# **AGO ORGANFEST** 2020

beauty in the midst of chaos





The American Guild of Organists is thrilled to announce the first online OrganFest, which will take place July 20-24. Each evening's broadcast will premiere a new work which had been commissioned for the 2020 National Convention in Atlanta, accompanied by interviews with the composers.

Featured performers will be Jens Korndörfer, Amanda Mole, Alan Morrison, Thomas Ospital, and Catherine Rodland. Additional recorded performances by recent international organ competition winners will be presented, and short presentations will share exciting news and updates from the AGO.

The daily YouTube premiere (8 p.m. Eastern) and accompanying Festival website will be available at no charge.

OrganFest 2020 promises to be an exciting way to showcase our beloved instrument and the great work of the AGO. Please share this information widely with your music-loving friends.

While we are saddened by the cancellation of many musical events this spring and summer, including our National Convention in Atlanta, we look forward to celebrating the future of organ music together online next month.



### Seven Oak's Presbyterian Church Organ Renovation

Thanks to God's guidance and provision, along with the support of the people of Seven Oaks Presbyterian Church, and the vision and dedication of Tom Lewtak and the Lewtak Organbuilders staff, our congregation now enjoys the music produced by our new organ.

This this new 22 rank instrument has over 1,300 pipes. The pipework was produced by Jacques Stinkens in the Netherlands, and by the Michal Kenis' pipe foundry in the Czech Republic. The pipework includes a 16' Open Principal in the Pedal division. All pipework was voiced with extraordinary care and skill to maximize the quality and clarity of each rank,



and to create a satisfying ensemble sound that takes full advantage of the building's acoustics. Pipe chests for the Great and Pedal divisions are electro-mechanical. and there are two slider chests for the newly enclosed Swell division, which is under expression. The Great and Pedal divisions are unenclosed. A completely new winding system was provided with the organ's installation, including a new blower and bellows. The two manual, stop tab console includes a beautiful inlaid wood pattern in a cabinet of Sapele wood. The keyboards are German built, with adjustable tracker-like action, granadilla naturals and bone sharps. The console also includes a modern capture system, transposer, variable speed tremulant, adjustable lighting and adjustable bench. The organ also has a new electronic relay and switching system. The organ is tuned to a temperament that is more consistent with classical temperaments, enhancing the overall quality of the sound, and adding a touch of historical authenticity to the music. The project was capped off with the installation of Tom Lewtak's beautifully designed and crafted organ façade, which both expanded the tonal egress from the chamber and significantly enhanced the aesthetic quality of the worship space. All in all, this project has transformed our church's music and worship by replacing our old Zimmer & Sons unit organ with an instrument having independent divisions creating an impressive sound, and a richness of colors across all the individual ranks. A dedicatory recital is being planned for later this year.
