### Park Road Baptist Church

Given my long standing relationship with R. A. Daffer Church Organs, Inc. and Al Murrell, having worked closely with them during the design and purchase of the 5 manual Ruffatti organ at Friendship Missionary Baptist Church, I knew of the integrity and fantastic customer service that Al and the Daffer organization are known for. When Park Road Church was struck by lightning during the summer of 2015, our Allen organ was severely damaged. We had the organ repaired several times and ultimately it was declared a total loss. Because we were going to be without an instrument for Christmas, Al volunteered a Rodgers organ so we would be able to have an organ for our Christmas choral





concert with members of the Charlotte Symphony.

The Chairman of the Administrative Committee, our Co-Pastors, as well as myself, all jumped on this opportunity, because we had been without an organ for going on six months. In a congregation that is known for its traditional liturgy and organ music, not having an organ began to take its toll on our musical offerings and congregational singing. The first Sunday with the temporary installation of the Rodgers 484, the congregation raised the roof with their singing.

Since then, the congregation has enjoyed the organ more and more and asks weekly what other sounds it can produce-from the variety of realistic pipe samples to orchestral samples. Even members of the Charlotte Symphony remarked at how realistic the orchestral samples were and that the Rodgers sounded just like a pipe organ! I am enjoying the organ immensely and look forward to my practice sessions and leading congregational singing with the organ. Thank

you for how you have enhanced our liturgy and for your personalized customer service. Your detail and concern has been noted by many people in our congregation after we had been let down by others. Relationships are built on trust and I had told people that I trusted you and the Daffer company from having worked with you before. Because of how you extended your hand to us, you have built a relationship of trust with the whole Park Road congregation and I thank you for that.
