<u>Directions to</u> <u>Ebenezer Lutheran</u> <u>Church</u>

From Orangeburg - Take I-26 West to Columbia. At Exit I-126/US 76 go East toward Downtown Columbia. When expressway ends continue straight (2 left lanes). This becomes Elmwood Ave. At. 4th light, turn right onto Sumter Street. Ebenezer is in second block on left.

From Newberry - Take I-26 East to Columbia. Continue on I-26 through the I-20 interchange and get in left 2 lanes. Bear left onto I-126/US toward 76 downtown Columbia. When expressway ends, continue straight (2 left lanes). This becomes Elmwood Ave. At 4th light, turn right onto Sumter Street. Ebenezer is in second block on left.

Parking Information

Park in the lot at the corner of Sumter and Calhoun and enter the metal door to the gym lobby
