Brian Bogdanowitz will provide theater organ music for the silent film, *Phantom of the Opera*. The 1925 silent film version, directed by Rupert Julian, is a classic adaptation of Gaston Leroux's novel *The Phantom of the Opera*, starring Lon Chaney in the title role as the masked and facially disfigured 'Phantom' who haunts the Paris Opera House, causing murder and mayhem in an attempt to force the management to make the woman he loves a star. It is most famous for Lon Chaney's intentionally horrific, self-applied makeup, which was kept a studio secret until the film's premiere.

Brian, known for his not-so-conventional organ concerts, is well known for his ninety-minute score to the *Phantom of the Opera*. He was featured on FOX Television Arts and Entertainment segment as the composer and performer of the music score. Brian currently teaches music at O2B Kids on Fleming Island, FL and is music director for St. Margaret's Episcopal Church in Green Cove Springs, FL.
